



Changes to the supply of goods to EU after June 30<sup>th</sup> 2021

From 30<sup>th</sup> June 2021 EU legislation will require all online sellers to register for VAT in the EU in order to supply goods to private consumers.

For small businesses this is not only costly in terms of administration but also a drain on limited resources that small businesses have.

As of 30<sup>th</sup> June 2021 we will no longer be able to supply private orders direct from the UK.

We are currently working with dealers based in the EU that will hopefully make our range of products available.

We will continue to supply businesses in the EU that have a valid VAT registration number and we will arrange to open accounts as required upon request.
