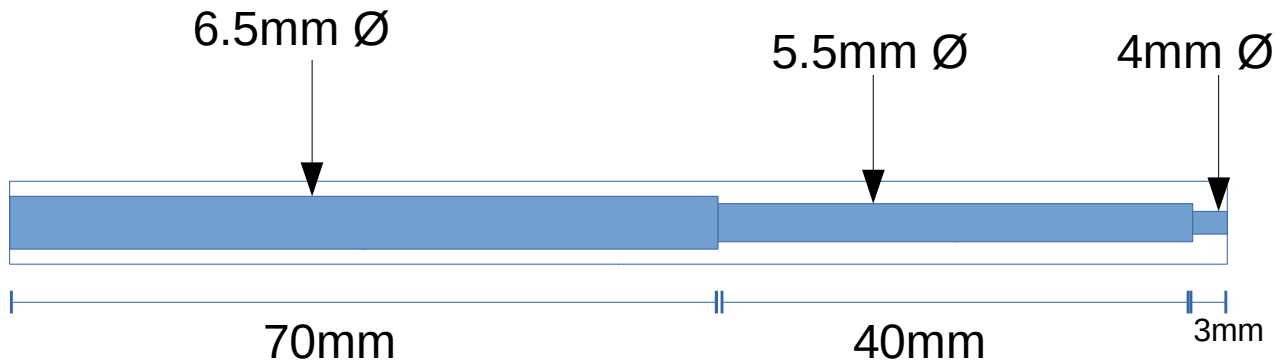


Dimensions & Guide for Mechanical Pencil Kits



We recommend a blank 112-115mm long

Once your blank has been drilled to the sizes in the diagram above it is advisable to check the fit of the kit before turning and hand finish the heel end if required.

A stepped drill for drilling is available separately (PKR Stepdrill) or may be done manually with individual drills if you have suitable ones

The prepared blank can be mounted on the Prokraft stepped mandrel (PPMAN) with bushings (PPBUSH) or turned between centres.

If using the mandrel and bushings please see the separate mounting instructions on the product listing on our website.

If turning between centres the nib end should be turned to 7mm and the heel end to 8.5mm. Do not exert too much pressure when turning between centres or you may split your blank.

The mechanical pencil kits require 0.5mm pencil nibs and are available separately
